

SATURDAY, JUNE 27, 1863.

Started early and
crossed the Potomac
by Pontons at Edwards
 Ferry. All the army moved
to intercept Lee's
army. I find a great
difference in the citizens
here from what they
are in Virginia.

SUNDAY 28

Marched through
Medtown and several
villages. I heard by the
citizens wherever we went
the Ladies giving us Bread
and Pie for nothing
Livy well

MONDAY 29

Marched into Pennsylvania
and then back to
Bloomers. The Rebels
all around

TUESDAY, JUNE 30, 1863.

Crossed into Maryland
and then to Pennsylvania
Passed through Sandy town
and then to Gettysburg
where we lay over night
Got plenty to eat
from the citizens

WEDNESDAY JULY 1

The Battle of Gettysburg
commenced to day. we spent
the fight with the 2 Brigades
of Cavalry and a few pieces of
artillery they drove us out
of our position so we fell back
to the town when the Infantry
moved up when we captured 500
Prisoners killed several by our
Artillery. we lost a few men.

THURSDAY 2

Went out scouting (on a squadron)
came in sight of the Rebels and
then marched back. The fighting
commenced early upon a most
bloody work done to day
how many that was a live
and full of life this morning
now slumps the slump of death
I left the field and went to
my tent out of rations

FRIDAY, JULY 3, 1863.

The fight commenced with terrible carnage early this morning some fearful work done to day. left Farmington and went to Westminster the Rebel prisoners convey in by the 1000? 4800 came through town to day.

SATURDAY 4

Dick Reburgh, surrendered sent a letter to John Pryor and his wife and his wife deserted, left here and went to Frederick. The Rebels in full retreat they suffered very heavy loss. loss pretty severe.

SUNDAY 5

Camped near Frederick the Rebels still retreating in great disorder.

MONDAY, JULY 6, 1863.

Left Frederick and marched towards Gauley Gap. met the Rebels at Yellow Springs fought them a few weeks. the Rebels captured 20 Prisoners. The Rebels broke and run.

TUESDAY 7

The Rebels called on our Regt. left as rear guard. The Rebels attacked us but we fought our way out. lost a few killed wounded and prisoners. I dont like this war the balls app. around in ears. the Rebels horse got shot. retreated to Brownsville.

WEDNESDAY 8

The Rebels attacked us this morning. we fought pretty well all day. none of our Co. hurt. the shells coming among us pretty thick and small balls too. drove them about 1 mile.
